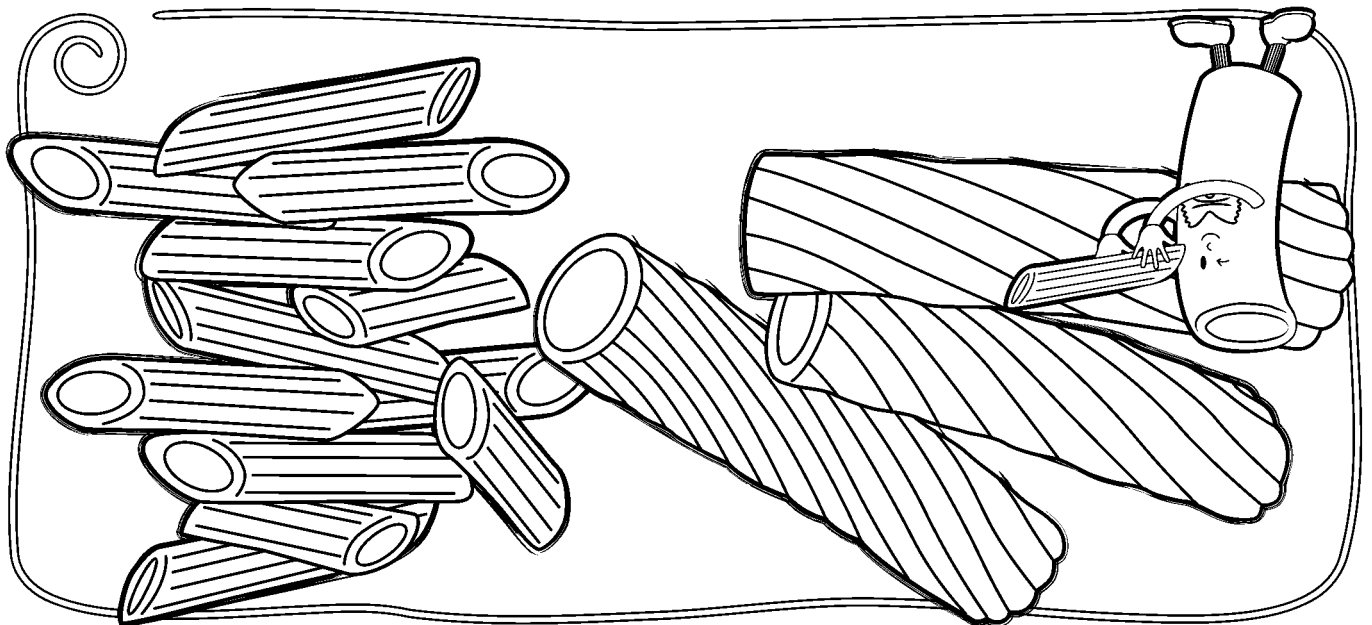


Spaghetti looks a lot like string.

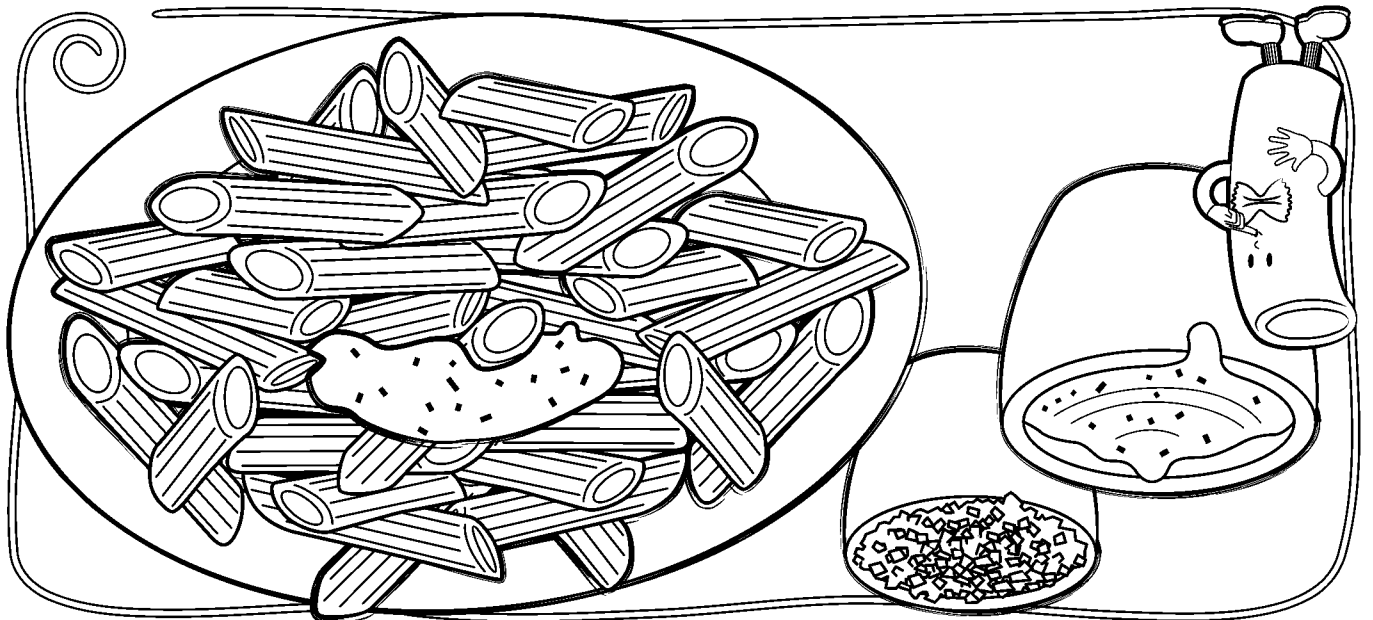


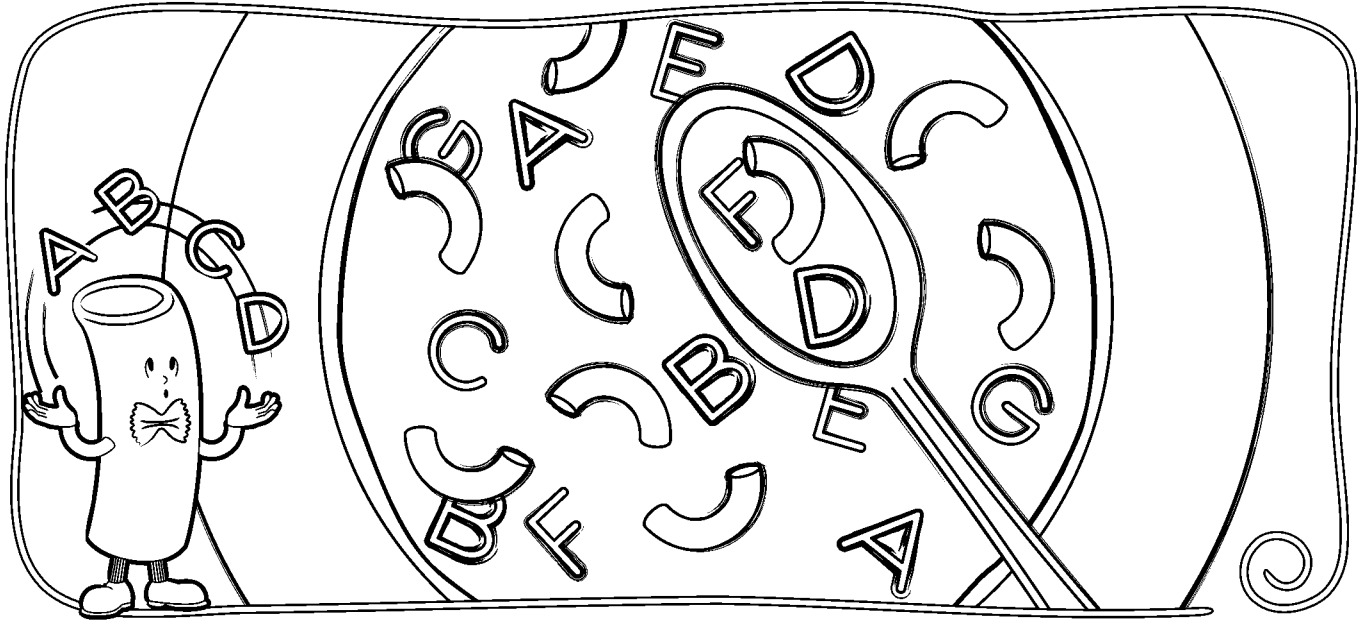
The sauce on top is often red.

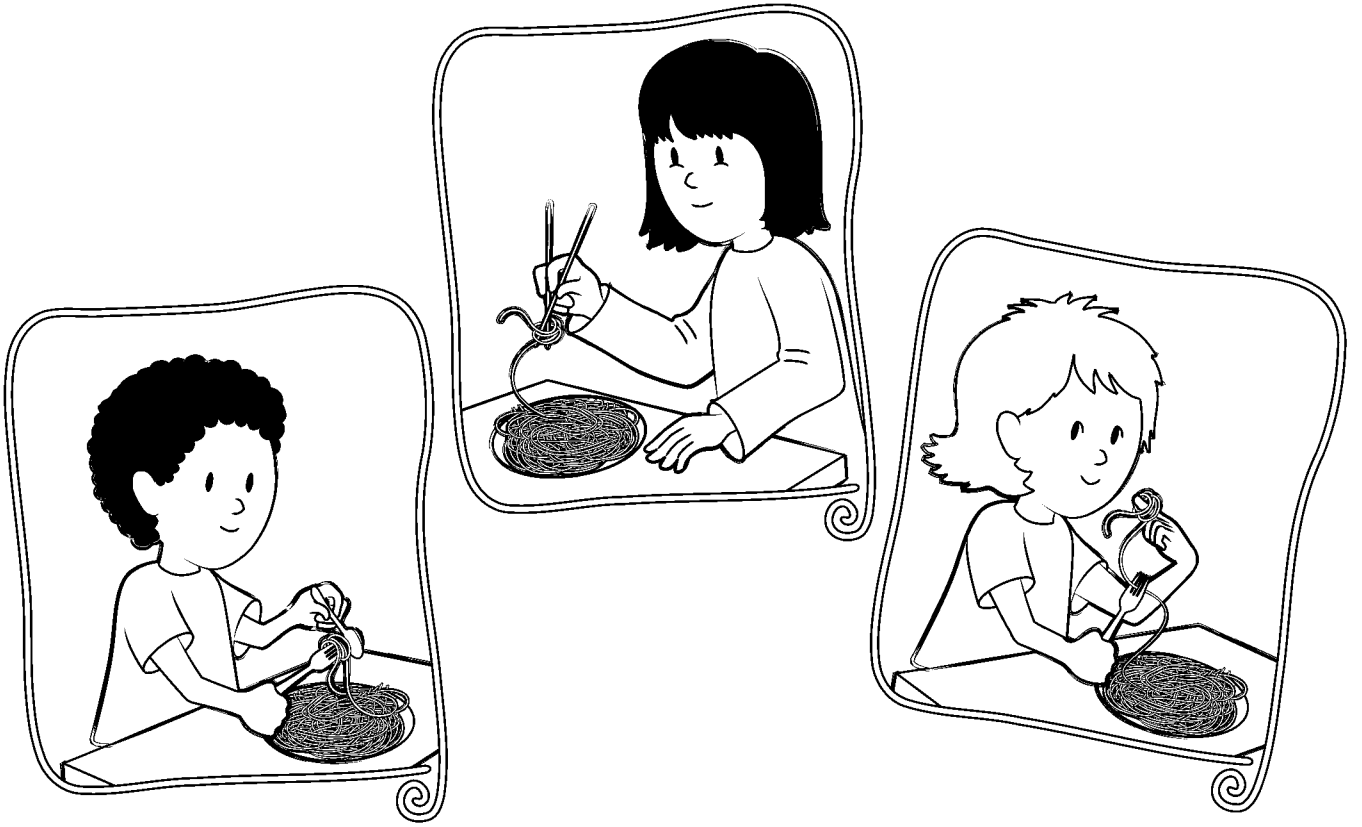


Macaroni and alphabet soup
